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GARO SCIP Compliance Statement

GARO is committed to complying with applicable requirements concerning Substances of Concern in Products (SCIP). SCIP is established under Article 9(1)(i) of the EU Waste Framework Directive (2008/98/EC) and requires suppliers of articles containing substances of very high concern (SVHCs) included on the REACH Candidate List above 0.1% by weight to submit relevant information to the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA).

GARO assesses its products and material information against the applicable requirements and submits SCIP notifications to ECHA where a notification obligation applies.

GARO continuously works with suppliers and internal product data to improve material transparency, product traceability and the accuracy of SCIP-related information.

This statement applies to GARO products placed on the EU market and is subject to applicable legislation and updates to the REACH Candidate List and SCIP requirements.
